Measure Description: Assesses the percentage of adults 66–80 years of age with advanced illness, an indication of frailty or who are receiving palliative care, and all adults 81 years of age and older, who had advance care planning during the measurement year.

Eligible Population

Medicare members 66 years of age and older with an advanced illness or frailty diagnosis, or who are receiving palliative care.

Exclusions

Members are excluded from the measure if they meet the following criteria:

• Members who are in hospice.

Measure Compliance (numerator)

Evidence of advance care planning during the measurement year including a discussion or documentation about preferences for resuscitation, life-sustaining treatment, and end of life care during the measurement year.
